DECADENT MARSHMALLOW TART...

1. BASE

150g butter
1 packet Marie biscuits

2. FILLING

1 cup milk
25 Marshmallows
100g Wholenut chocolate

3. METHOD

Crush biscuits in a plastic bag with a rolling pin.
Melt butter, add crushed biscuits & mix well.
Press into greased pie dish & chill.
For filling- boil milk & add to marshmallows, stir until melted.
Remove from heat & add chocolate until melted.
Pour filling into base when cool, refrigerate until set.
Decorate with rosettes of fresh cream & chocolate dipped strawberries!






