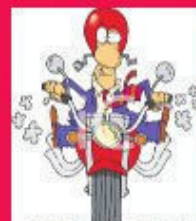

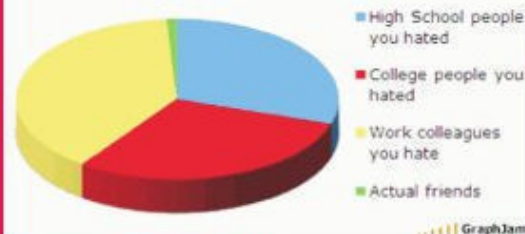

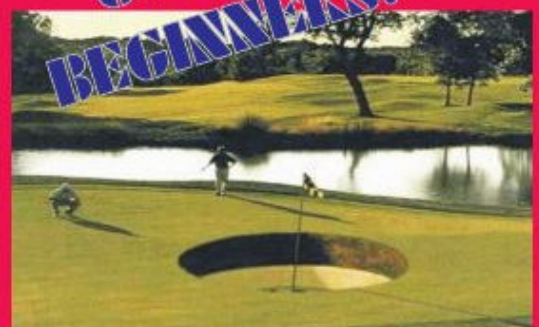

METHOD...

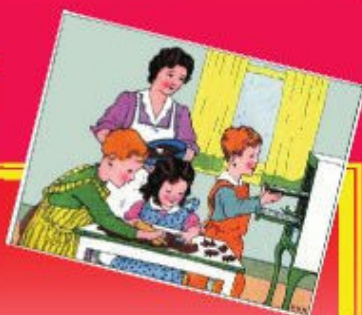
Grease a large loaf tin well.

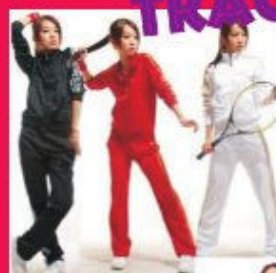

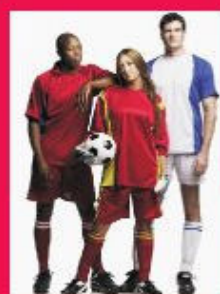
